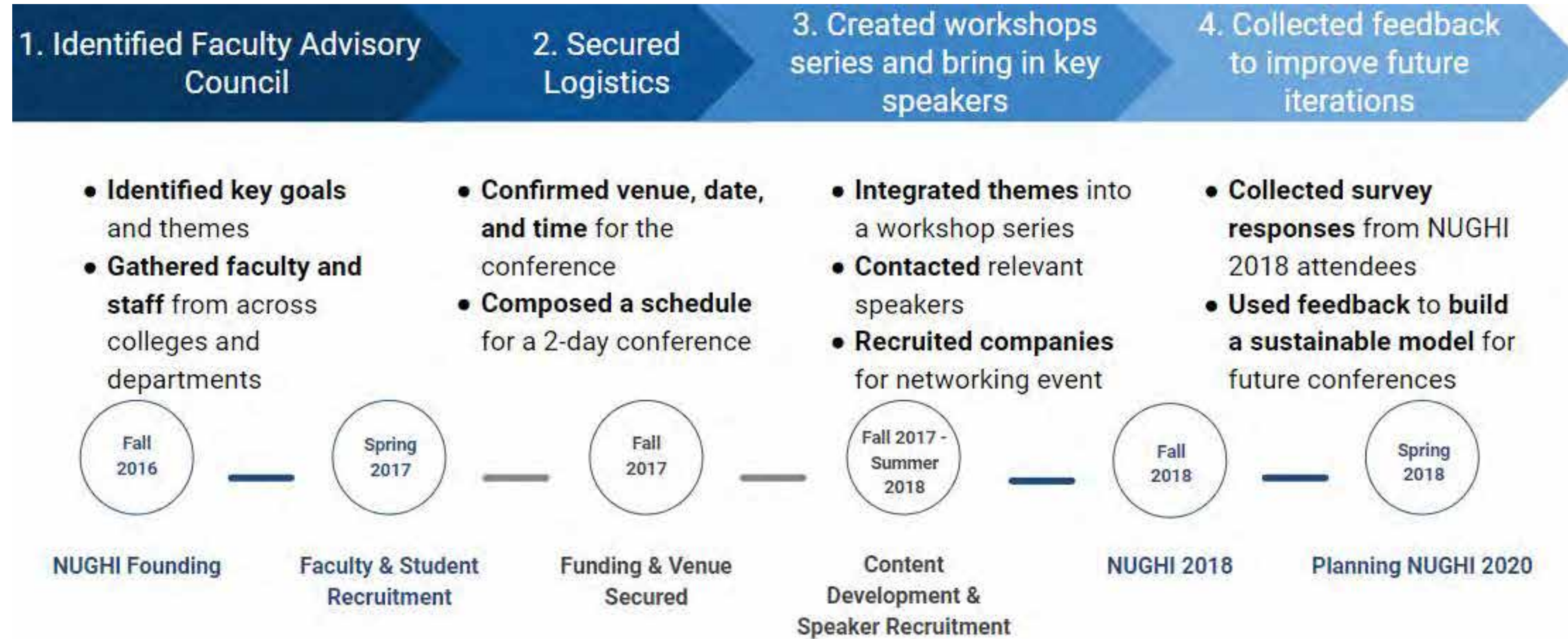


## Accomplishments

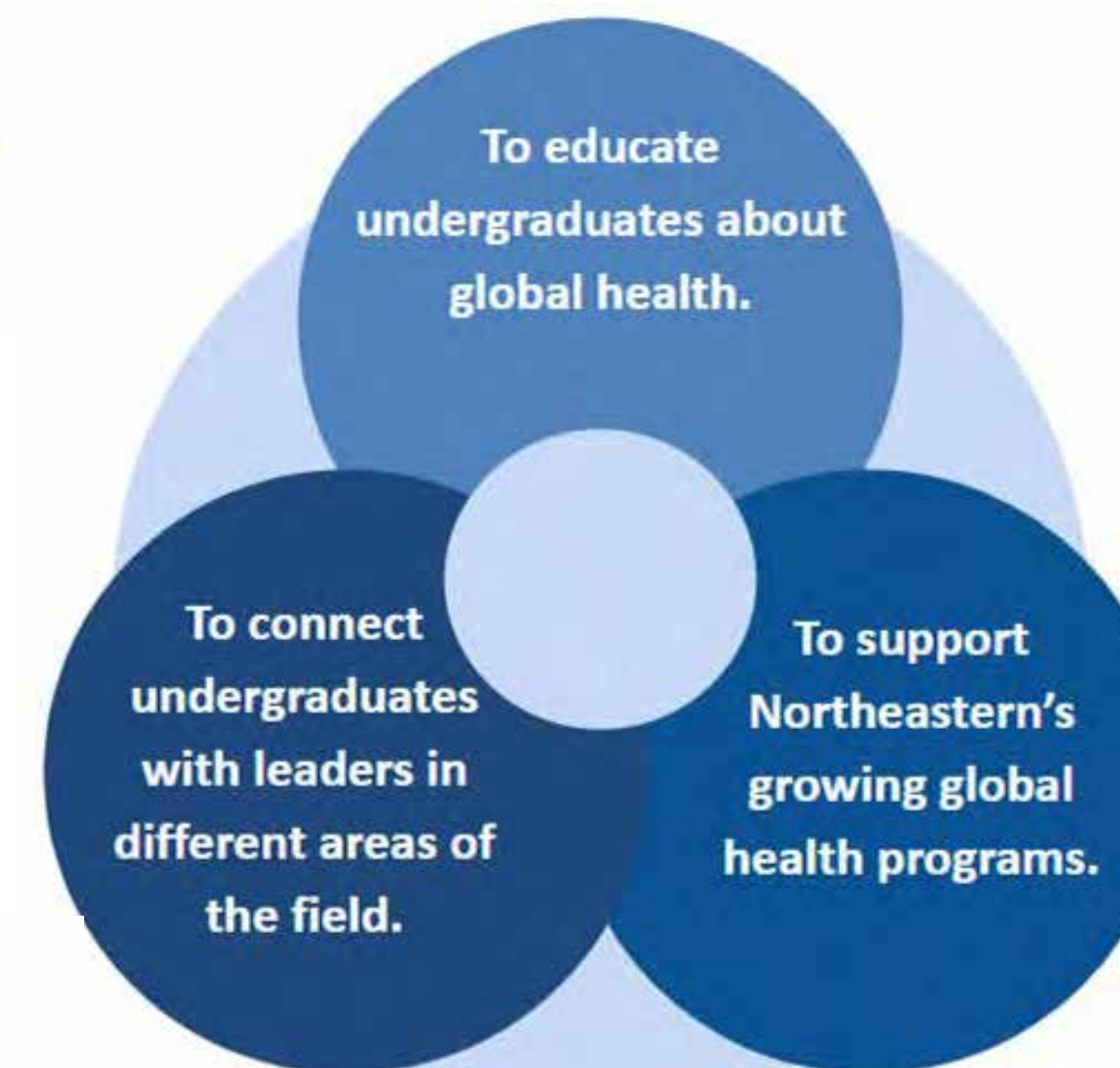
This year, MFW participated in many outreach and advocacy programs both around Boston and around the country.

### Around the country:

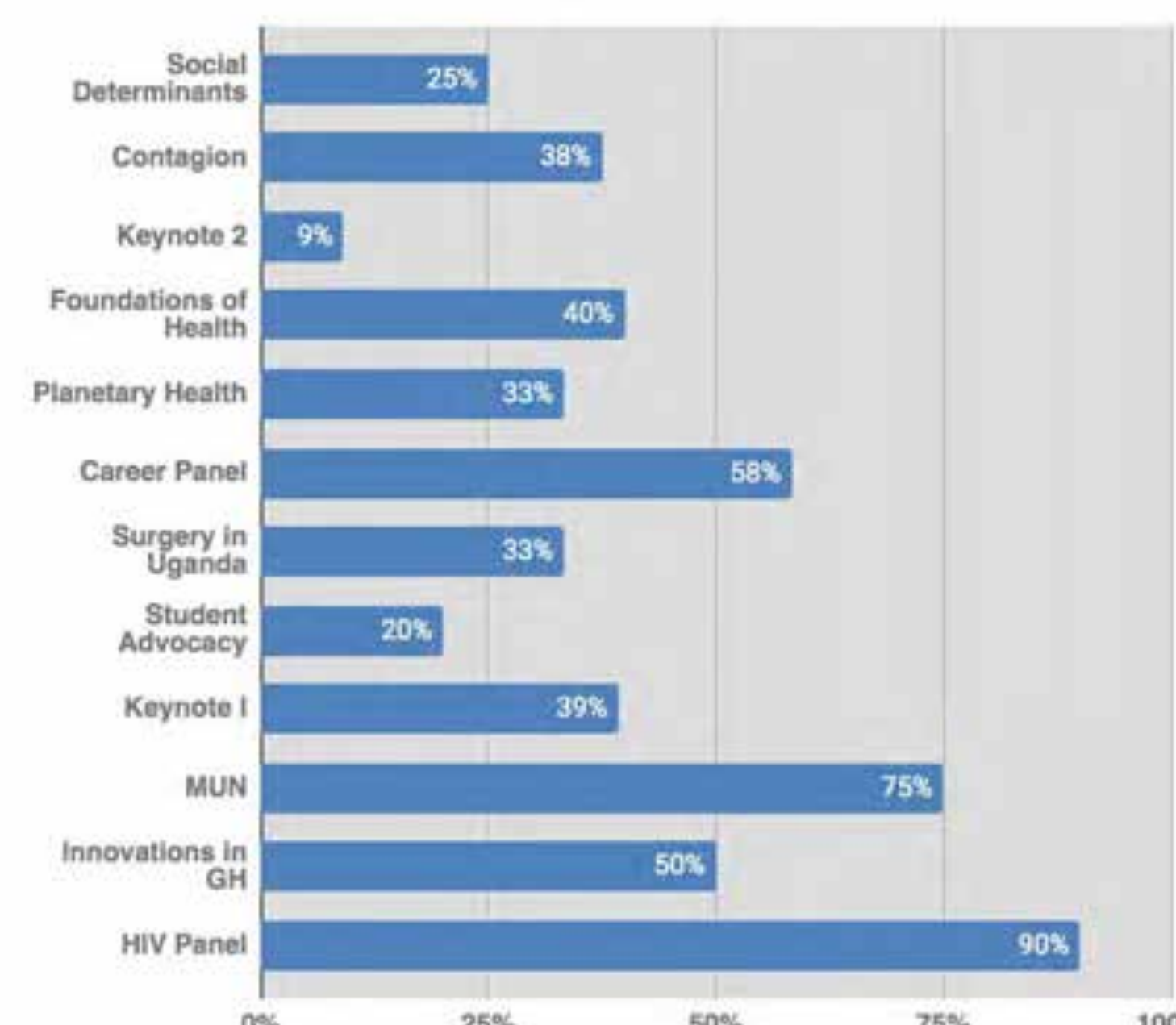
- Gave a keynote at the UN Nothing But Nets Summit
