Congratulations on beginning your journey as a post-baccalaureate pre-health student! We are excited you're here, and our advising team is ready to support you in reaching your academic and professional goals!

You will have **two primary advisors** during your time in the post-bacc program: an **academic advisor** and a **pre-health advisor**. These two advisors work collaboratively but have distinct roles and ways in which they can help support you.
