GETTING STARTED

Congratulations on beginning your journey as a post-baccalaureate pre-health student! We are excited you're here, and our advising team is ready to support you in reaching your academic and professional goals!

You will have **two primary advisors** during your time in the post-bacc program: an **academic advisor** and a **pre-health advisor**. These two advisors work collaboratively but have distinct roles and ways in which they can help support you. We recommend that you first meet with your academic advisor and then schedule a follow-up meeting with your pre-health advisor.
